Dr.SiddharthMisraandMs.Namrata Nanda defined what is an Intellectual property right its types such as patent, copy right, trademark, trade secret, geographical indications etc. The resource persons also discussed the types of works that can be eligible for IPR and explained various treaties and conventions such as Paris convention, Berne Convention, WIPO Copyright Treaty, Budapest Treaty, The Patent Cooperation Treaty for protection of Industrial products, literary, artistic Works etc. Indian Patent and Designs act enacted in 1999 and then later several amendments were introduced which are indicative of India's commitment to prepare ourselves for the global trade competition. They also discussed about the different laws pertaining to patent law and explained the role of patent agents and patent attorneys, enforce attorneys, transactional

Intellectual property law protects against disclosure of trade secrets which further signifies protection against unfair competition. This makes the intellectual property an asset which is more valuable than owning a tangible asset. This is most clearly visible in the field of technology and the digital economy. If there were no intellectual property practices and statutes governing the functioning of IP laws, there would have been no new creation of works and hard work of someone could be stolen and it would have spread around the world without paying any cost to its creator for his labor on the invention.

• The most important place for prior art search is "worldwide patent system". Two prior art search processes are present which are a product search and a patent search. The first step is finding a right keyword and special technical terms in order to search for relevant content. They explained the proper keywords such as Rodent trap or mouse trap generate 20,000 vs 700 patent inventions.
